You agree that Valley of the Hounds and the Veterinarian will make the most compassionate and reasonable judgment as the situation dictates. Authorized Pickup:

You agree that you may verbally (telephone, etc.) or in writing (i.e., e-mail) request that Valley of the Hounds release your dog to someone other than the person(s) listed below, you release Valley of the Hounds of and from any and all responsibility for releasing your dog to any person Valley of the Hounds believes to be authorized by you. **Valley of the Hounds will release your dog to the following person(s) with proper ID:**



Agreement:

VOTH cannot guarantee that toys, blankets, bed, etc. will be kept in the same condition as brought in. VOTH will not be responsible for loss or damage to property (i.e., leashes, collars, etc.) brought or left at VOTH. Property left longer than seven days after pet's pick-up will be disposed of or donated. Pets found to harbor external parasites will be provided a flea/tick bath and have preventative applied at the owner's expense. Pets found to harbor internal parasites (i.e. worms); will be treated by a vet at the owner's expense, including transportation fees. All reasonable attempts will be made to contact the owner prior to treatment.

All dogs, over 8 months old, must be spayed or neutered, and have all vaccinations. Unaltered dogs will not be allowed to interact with other dogs. All dogs must be on a leash; all other pets (cats, rabbits, etc.) will be in a carrier at all times while on VOTH property.

Owner understands the risks involved with communal boarding of dogs. VOTH provides reasonable care and supervision, however, the unpredictable personality of dogs and their interaction can sometimes lead to injury or illness. VOTH will not be responsible for any veterinarian expenses related to Bordatella (Please refer to the Bordatella Fact Sheet), or minor bites or scratches.

Owner understands that VOTH's liability, of any circumstance related to the dog, will not exceed \$500.00. Full payment for services is required at the time of pick-up. VOTH will have a lien on the pet to ensure payment and may retain custody of the pet until all payments are made in full. Charges will continue to accrue while pet awaits pick-up or once VOTH has determined a final disposition for the pet (i.e. re-homed, euthanized, etc.) VOTH may sell the pet or dispose of the pet in any humane manner it wishes. All proceeds of the sale will belong to VOTH. If the proceeds are insufficient to pay in full, all unpaid charges and costs of sale, the owner shall remain liable for the difference. Pets boarding more than seven days, will be billed weekly, charged on or about each seventh day.

Owner understands they are responsible for damage their canine may inflict to property beyond normal wear and tear. The canine may be relocated from a reserved location to a more appropriate one, at VOTH's discretion due to the canine's behavior, i.e. destruction, fence fighting, excessive barking. The daily rate will be adjusted accordingly for the relocation.

Owner understands that their pet's first name, photo, and likenesses of their pet may be used for advertising and promotional purposes on the internet, brochures, television, etc. VOTH has the right to reproduce and duplicate as they desire, free and clear of any claim whatsoever on the owner's part.

Limitation, attorney's fees and related costs, arising out of or related to the services provided by VOTH which may arise from the sole gross negligence or intentional and willful misconduct of VOTH, including, without limitation: (i) any inaccuracy in any statement made by yourself or information provided by you to Valley of the Hounds (ii) your pet, including but not limited to destruction of property, dog bites and transmission of disease, and (iii) any action by yourself which is in breach of the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

Due to the communal nature of our playgroups, and for safety/liability concerns, VOTH does not allow any aggressive dogs for boarding, grooming, or daycare. It is the Owner's responsibility to inform VOTH if pet has exhibited any aggressive tendencies or bitten anyone previously.

VOTH reserves the right, without notice, to adjust its fees for services. Please inquire at the front desk as to our current fees. Valley of the Hounds reserves the right to refuse service to customers whose pets may pose a threat to us or to other pets left in our care.

VOTH will not be held responsible for any sickness or injury caused by the pet to itself during boarding, grooming, or daycare. VOTH will not be responsible for any accidental death due to a pre-existing health condition or natural disasters (fire, storm, flood, etc.). VOTH will not be held responsible for clipper burn and/or minor nicks resulting from grooming of matted, neglected coats or for irritation caused by removing coat from pets possessing skin issues, or for the stressful effects grooming may have on an elderly or sensitive pet. VOTH reserves the right to charge additional fees for services VOTH considers to be above the norm covered by our standard rates.

I agree that I have read and understand the rules and conditions for Valley of the Hounds. I agree to release, hold harmless, acquit, will indemnify and forever discharge the corporation from all, and in all manner of action and actions, suits, damages, judgments, executions, claims and demands whatsoever, in law or in equity, which I, or any other person I have with me while on VOTH property or during boarding, daycare, or grooming at Valley of the Hounds.

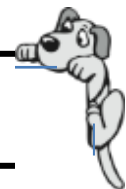
